

NOTE: The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's publication "Guidance for Controlling Asbestos-Containing Materials in Buildings", EPA 560/5-85-024, includes helpful information on asbestos abatement. The most recent edition of this EPA publication should be read before performing any asbestos abatement work.

#### **General Information**

The TeleShower Model \$5000ET is used for personnel decontamination after asbestos abatement work is performed. It is corrosion-resistant, lightweight and has a telescoping feature to enhance portability.

### TeleShower Setup and Breakdown

Note: The TeleShower \$5000ET is designed for indoor use only.

Note: The extending or collapsing of the shower unit requires two people.

Note: If the TeleShower is used in conjunction with a pump/filtration unit, be sure to carefully follow the operating instructions for the pump/filtration unit.

- 1. Extend the TeleShower as follows:
  - a) Place one foot on the rolled edge of the base at shower opening.
  - b) Push up on shower lid until the retractable pins have locked into place.
- 2. a) Remove the plastic cap which covers the opening and pull up on the hinged shower floor.
  - b) Check to ensure that the 100 micron bag filter is in place under the shower drain.
  - c) Lower the hinged floor back into place against the shower base
- 3. Attach the metal hooks to the shower curtains and shower lid. Curtains should hang on the inside of the shower to prevent contaminated water from splashing outside the unit.
- 4. Connect hot and cold water sources to their respective fittings in top section of shower.
- 5. Using a garden-type water hose with standard fittings, connect the drain plug at base of shower to building drain system.
- 6. Collapse the TeleShower as follows:
  - a) Hold the top section of shower in place and pull pins to release them from their locked position.
  - b) Slide the top section of shower down into its base.

#### Filter Replacement

The TeleShower is equipped with a 100 micron filter bag. This filter removes contaminants which are 100 microns or larger in size from the water which drains into the shower base. As the filter becomes loaded with debris, the flow of water through the drain slows noticeably and the filter should be replaced as follows:

Note: Personnel responsible for changing the filter should wear the necessary personal protective equipment in accordance with federal, state, and employer requirements.

- 1. Turn water faucets "OFF."
- 2. If a pump/filtration unit is being used, turn it "OFF" and remove the water level sensor from the shower floor opening.
- 3. If a pump/filtration unit is not being used, remove the plastic cap which covers the opening in the shower floor for the water level sensor.
- 4. Pull up on the hinged shower floor, remove the \$5110B filter bag from its channelled housing and dispose of the filter as asbestos waste.
- 5. Place a new \$5110B filter into the channelled housing and lower the hinged floor back into place against the shower base.
